TRANSPORTATION (Movement of goods and people)

April 2018

- Create a “pedestrian walkway” during festivals held in the neighbourhood (i.e., shut down the streets to cars)
- Ask OC Transpo to create a “green pass” for Hintonburg residents. This would involve the use of zone fares & provide discounts to those travelling shorter distances (i.e., people living in Hintonburg & nearby neighbourhoods who travel to downtown vs. people who travel from the suburbs to downtown). This type of fare structure is common in other cities.
- Install infrastructure for electric vehicles.
- Municipal vehicle fleet should be using less fossil fuel. Instead they should use hybrids/smart-charging infrastructure like plug-in stations. The Federation of Canadian Municipalities has funding for this type of initiative.
